

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(DARLTON FOOTPATH NO.8) DIVERSION ORDER 2021

This Order is made by the Nottinghamshire County Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath and the public it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

The Bassetlaw District Council and The Dunham On Trent, Darlton, Ragnall and Fledborough Parish Council have been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situate at Darlton and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up after 7 days from the date of confirmation and Certification of this Order.
2. There shall at the end of 7 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be Footpath over the land situate at Darlton as described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

Description of Site of Existing Path or Way

Commencing from a point, SK 7785 7264, at the junction with the remainder of Darlton Footpath No.8 and proceeding for a distance of approximately 439 metres in a generally east-north-easterly then southerly direction to a point, SK 7720 7265, at the junction with the remainder of Darlton Footpath No.8 with a recorded width of 1.5 metres throughout.

PART 2

Description of Site of New Path or Way

Commencing from a point, SK 7785 7264, at the junction with the remainder of Darlton Footpath No.8 and proceeding for a distance of approximately 401 metres in a southerly then generally easterly direction to a point, SK 7720 7265, at the junction with the remainder of Darlton Footpath No.8 with a width of 1.5 metres throughout on surfaces of crushed stone and grass.

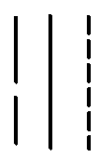
Parish and Path No. Affected: Darlton Footpath No. 8

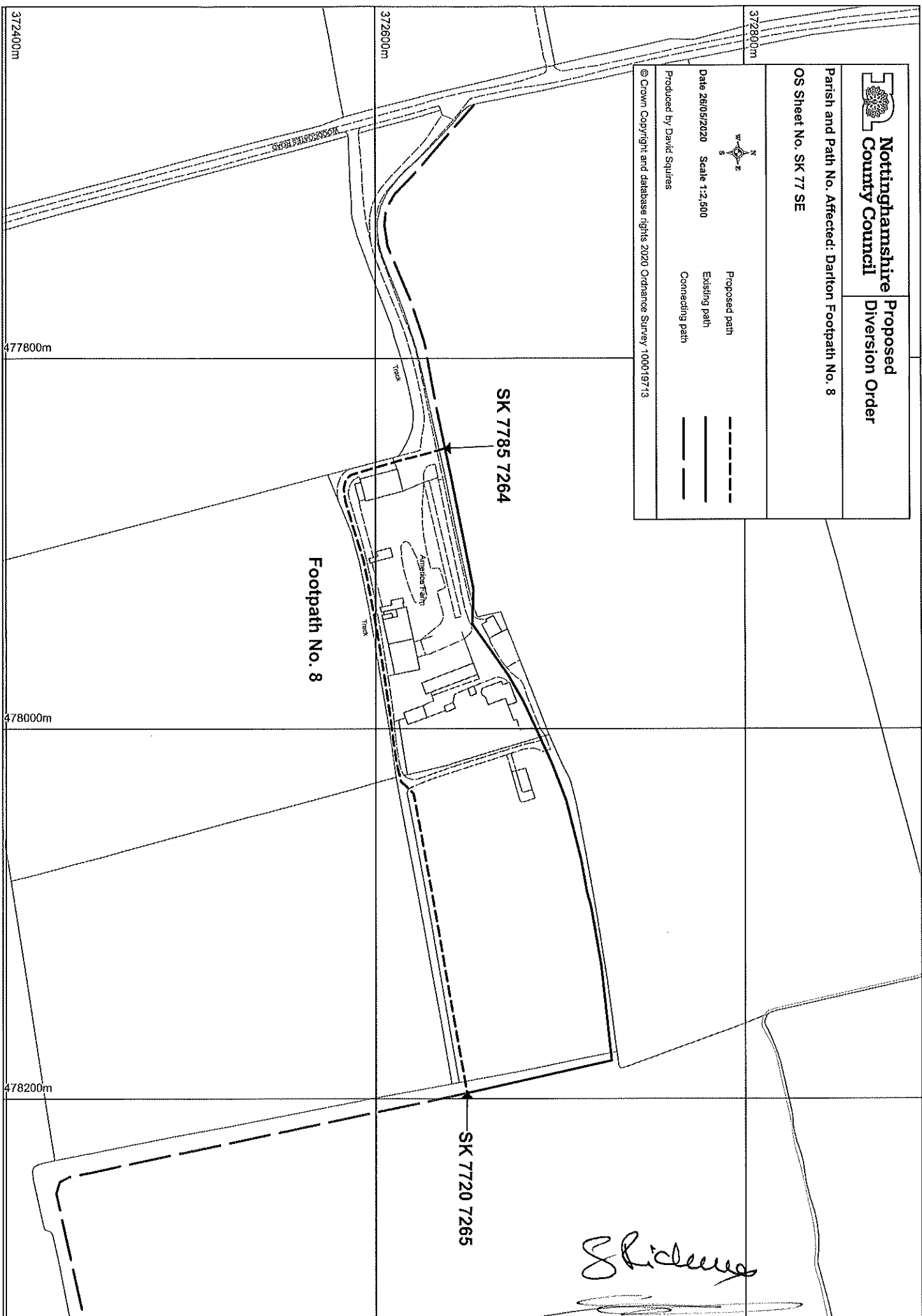
