

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BYWAY

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (HAYTON BYWAY NO.10) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION ORDER 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council HAS MADE an ORDER, under Sections 14 and 15(8) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:

To continue the effects of THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (<u>HAYTON</u> <u>BYWAY NO.10</u>) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) NOTICE <u>2021</u>.

That Notice came into force on 23rd April 2021.

The effects are that: -

No person shall: -

- (a) proceed on foot,
- (b) cause any pedal cycle to proceed,
- (c) cause any horse to proceed,
- (d) cause any animal to proceed or
- (e) cause any vehicle to proceed

in the following length of Byway at Hayton in the District of Bassetlaw -

<u>Hayton Byway No.10</u>, its entire length, between grid reference points SK 7281 8479, the junction with Main Street and SK 7301 8483 the junction with Hayton Byway 27, a distance of 210 metres.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction the alternative route available for byway users will be as follows: -

Main Street, Hayton Byway 4 (Burntleys Road), Hayton Byway 27 (Lover's Walk) and vice versa

<u>IT IS INTENDED</u> that the prohibition respecting the above highway or highways will apply as follows:-

To 22nd October 2021 inclusive.

The Continuation Order will come into force on 14th May 2021 and any prohibition contained in the continued Order shall apply on that day and on any subsequent day or days when it shall be necessary for the prohibition to apply to enable works to be carried out and the Order shall continue in full force until the works it is proposed to carry out are completed. The duration of this Order may be extended with the approval of the relevant Secretary of State.

The prohibition is required to protect public safety due to surface damage, and to enable repairs to be carried out.
