

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (EAST RETFORD FOOTPATH NO.36)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION NO.2 ORDER 2021**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State Transport in pursuance of the powers conferred by Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 approves of The Nottinghamshire County Council (East Retford Footpath No.36) (Temporary Prohibition) Notice 2020 (which came into force on 1st December 2020 and was continued in force by a Continuation Order which remains in force until 31st May 2021 inclusive) being extended and continuing in force until 31st May 2022 or until completion of the relevant works, whichever is the sooner.

The Order has the following effect:-

No person shall: -

- (a) proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at East Retford in the District of Bassetlaw: -

East Retford Footpath No.36 from the southern end of Five Fields Lane at SK 7141 7965 to SK 7188 7940, a distance of approximately 575metres.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction there is no alternative route available for pedestrians on public rights of way.

If the works are not completed within the above period, the Order may be extended for a longer period with the further approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The prohibition is required to enable approved housing development works to be carried out, and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the footpath.
