Adding a bridleway in the parish of Beeston running from Meadow Road at SK541357 to Beeston FP63  
 at SK544360 and from the end of Beeston FP63 at SK547363 to the City boundary at SK548362.  
 Upgrading to a bridleway the footpath known as Beeston FP63 from SK544360 to SK548362.

Adding a bridleway in the City of Nottingham running from City boundary at SK548362 to the footpath  
 Nottingham 303 at SK557364 (Grove Cottage).

Upgrading to bridleway the footpaths known as Nottingham 303 and 275 from SK557364 (Grove  
 Cottage) to Trent Lane at SK561368

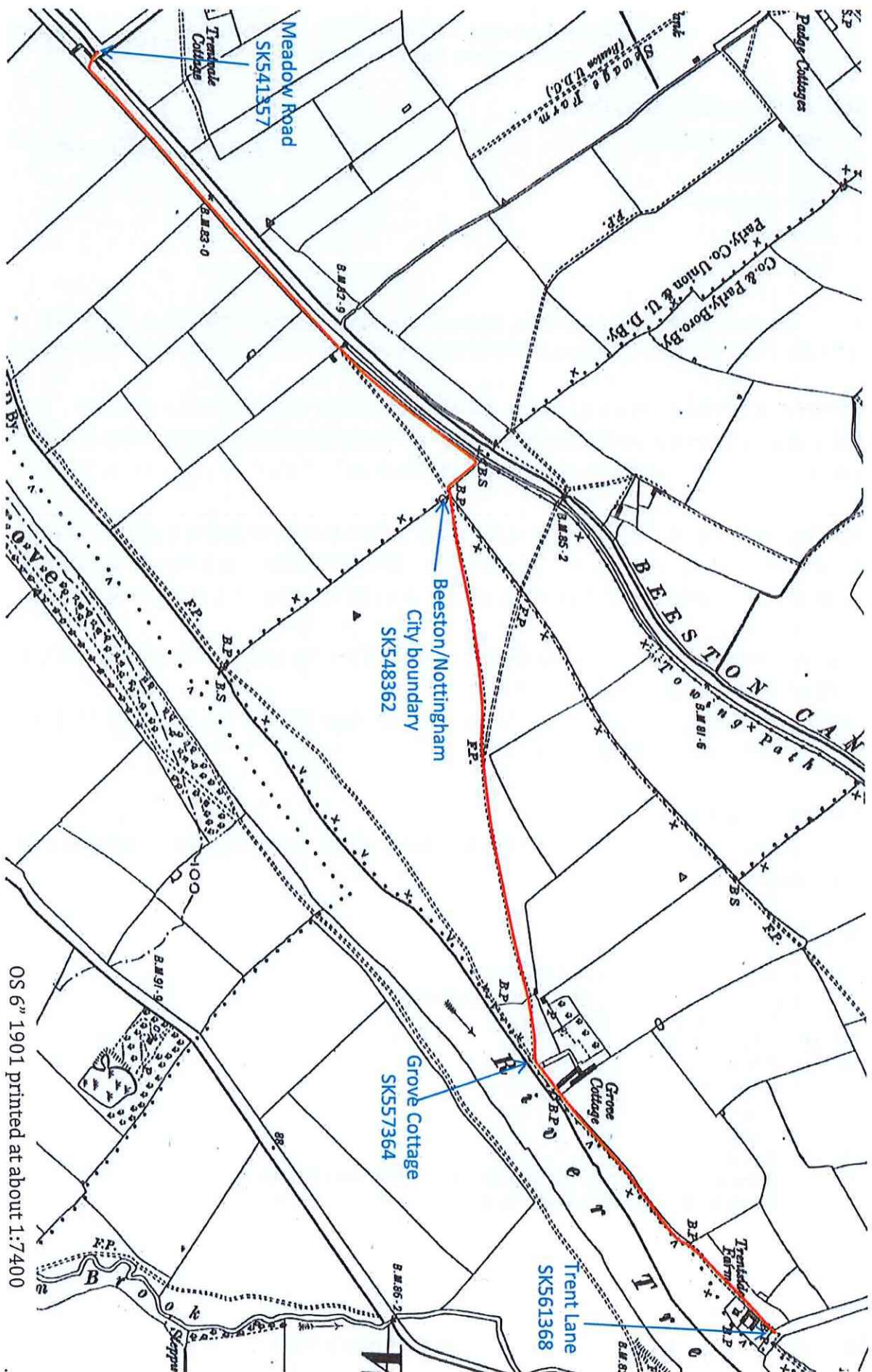
