

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATHS

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (CARLTON IN LINDRICK FOOTPATH NO.32 AND NO.33) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) ORDER 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this Notice to make an Order, under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be: -

No person shall: - Proceed on foot

in the following lengths of Footpath at Carlton in Lindrick in the District of Bassetlaw: -

Carlton in Lindrick Footpath No.32 its entire length between Rotherham Baulk (Road) at grid reference point SK 5793 8545 and Langold Country Park at SK 5794 8618, a distance of 880 metres.

Carlton in Lindrick Footpath No.33 between its junction with Footpath No.32 at grid reference point SK 5806 8604 and its junction with Footpath No.35 at SK 5764 8601, a distance of 430 metres.

IT IS INTENDED that the prohibition will apply as follows:-

From Monday, 21st June 2021 until Friday, 20th August 2021 inclusive.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction the alternative route will be via the Rotherham Footpath at Buckwood Farm then Carlton in Lindrick Footpath No.24, No.35 and No.33 to reach Langold Country Park, and vice versa.

The prohibition shall apply to enable works to be carried out and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the footpaths. It may also apply on subsequent days when it shall be necessary. If the works are not completed within 6 months, the Order may be extended.

The prohibition is required to enable environmental works including installation of reptile fencing and translocation of seed bank, and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the footpaths.

THIS CLOSURE WILL ONLY TAKE EFFECT WHEN SIGNS INDICATING CLOSURE ARE DISPLAYED

WHEN SAFE THE PATHS WILL REOPEN AT WEEKENDS AND THE CLOSURE WILL BE KEPT AS BRIEF AS POSSIBLE.
