- Adding a bridleway in the parish of Egmanton from point **A** on Tuxford Road, Egmanton to point **C** on Top Lane, Egmanton.
- Adding a bridleway in the parish of Egmanton from point **B** on Top Lane, Egmanton to point **D** on Kirton Road, Egmanton.
