



TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (SUTTON IN ASHFIELD FOOTPATH NO.25)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION ORDER 2021**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council HAS MADE an ORDER, under Sections 14 and 15(8) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:

To continue the effects of THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (**SUTTON IN ASHFIELD PUBLIC FOOTPATH 25**) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) NOTICE **2021**.

That Notice came into force on 20th May 2021.

The effects are that: -

No person shall: - proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at Sutton in Ashfield in the District of Ashfield -

Sutton in Ashfield Footpath No.25, from the junction with Footpath No.36 at grid reference SK 4696 6095 to the junction with Footpath No.26 at grid reference SK 4665 6066, comprising a distance of approximately 420 metres.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction the alternative route available for pedestrians will be as follows: -

Sutton in Ashfield Footpath No.36, Bridleway No.151 and Footpath No.26 and vice versa

IT IS INTENDED that the prohibition respecting the above highway or highways will apply as follows:-

To 19th November 2021 inclusive.

The Continuation Order will come into force on 10th June 2021 and any prohibition contained in the continued Order shall apply on that day and on any subsequent day or days when it shall be necessary for the prohibition to apply to enable works to be carried out and the Order shall continue in full force until the works it is proposed to carry out are completed. The duration of this Order may be extended with the approval of the relevant Secretary of State.

The prohibition is required to protect public safety due to a damaged culvert, and to facilitate repairs.
