MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER 2021

This Order is made by the Nottinghamshire County Council (“the Authority”) under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 (“the 1980 Act”) because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owners of the land crossed by the footpath it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

This Order is also made under Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (“the 1981 Act”) because it appears to the Authority that the Rushcliffe Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53 (3) (a) (i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the Map and Statement.

The Rushcliffe Borough Council has been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situate at Sutton Bonington and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up after confirmation and certification of this Order, and thereupon the Rushcliffe Definitive Map shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way.
2. There shall upon confirmation of this Order be footpath over the land situate at Sutton Bonington described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order, and thereupon the Rushcliffe Definitive Map shall be modified by adding that path to it.
3. The Rushcliffe Definitive Statement shall be modified as described in Part 3 of the Schedule to this Order.

Commencing from a point, SK 5214 2603, at the junction with the remainder of Sutton Bonington Footpath No. 1 and proceeding for a distance of approximately 210 metres in a north-easterly direction to a point SK 5233 2609, at the junction with the remainder of Sutton Bonington Footpath No. 1.

Description of Site of New Path or Way

Commencing from a point, SK 5214 2603, at the junction with the remainder of Sutton Bonington Footpath No. 1 and proceeding for a distance of approximately 340 metres in a south-easterly, east-south-easterly then in a generally north-north-easterly direction to a point, SK 5233 2609, at the junction with the remainder of Sutton Bonington Footpath No. 1.

General Description:	Proceeds through St Anne's Church Yard for a distance of approximately 60 metres in a generally easterly direction, crossing a bridge over a railway line, then proceeding through fields for a distance of approximately 1,690 metres in a generally east-north-easterly direction to a point, SK 5214 2603, then crossing a paddock and passing through paddocks for a distance of approximately 343 metres in a south easterly, east-south-easterly, and finally north-north-easterly direction.
