I refer to your recent Freedom of Information request. The response is as detailed below and in the attached document.

1. Please will you tell me how and when you have spent, or intend to spend, the S106 contributions made by developers with respect to the various housing developments in East Leake in the period of the current Rushcliffe Local plan and in the period immediately previous to this, relating to public transport, road safety, pavements, highways improvements etc.

I attach a table I have compiled for the developments I know about, but it may be incomplete or inaccurate.

Please see table one in the attached spreadsheet.

2. How and when will public transport be provided to the site on Lantern Lane which has recently been granted reserved matters approval for 195 affordable homes?

Please see table two in the attached spreadsheet which details the point within the construction programme at which the bus service contribution will be paid.

3. What are your plans going forward to connect East Leake by public transport to the employment opportunities in the area of the airport and the redeveloped Ratcliffe on Soar Power Station site?

Nottinghamshire County Council was recently successful with a funding bid to the Department for Transport Rural Mobility Fund for a pilot project to provide Demand Responsive Transport (DRT). New vehicles will operate in parts of Rushcliffe District including East Leake. They will provide access to the Ratcliffe on Soar Power Station site and other destinations including East Midlands Enterprise Gateway (EMEG), East Midlands Airport, The University of Nottingham's Sutton Bonington Campus, Stanford Hall Defence Medical Rehabilitation Centre and for onward travel at East Midlands Parkway Station and Nottingham Express Transit (NET) Tram Clifton Park & Ride. The new service will provisionally commence in late 2021.

4. Are there any other plans under consideration to change the existing bus services to East Leake or otherwise improve the public transport offer to this area?
