I refer to your recent Freedom of Information request.

Please could you provide us with a breakdown of how many potholes or highway repairs have been requested by the County Councillors for Gedling over the past 12 months (up until 5th Feb 2021), detailing on what roads and in which part of the Division, as detailed below:

- Carlton East Division - how many have been logged and where in Netherfield, Colwick, Stoke Bardolph and Burton Joyce by Cllr Nicki Brooks
- Arnold North Division - how many have been logged and where in Mapperley Plains, Arnold, Redhill, Woodthorpe and Bestwood by Cllr Michael Payne and Cllr Pauline Allen
- Arnold South Division - how many have been logged and where in Phoenix, Porchester, Woodthorpe, Arnold and Daybrook by Cllr John Clarke and Cllr Muriel Weisz

Please see the attached document for the response. Please note that this list should not be considered definitive, as there is no validation on logging eg, a councillor could raise a matter anonymously or not use the Cllr flag.
