hereby apply for an order under Section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the Nottinghamshire Definitive Map and Statement for the District of Gedling by

- Adding a bridleway from point A on the map to point C
- Adding a bridleway from point G to point H
- Upgrading to a bridleway the footpath known as Bestwood FP5 from point C to the junction with Bestwood FP4 at point D.
- Upgrading to a bridleway the footpath known as Bestwood FP4 from point D to point K.

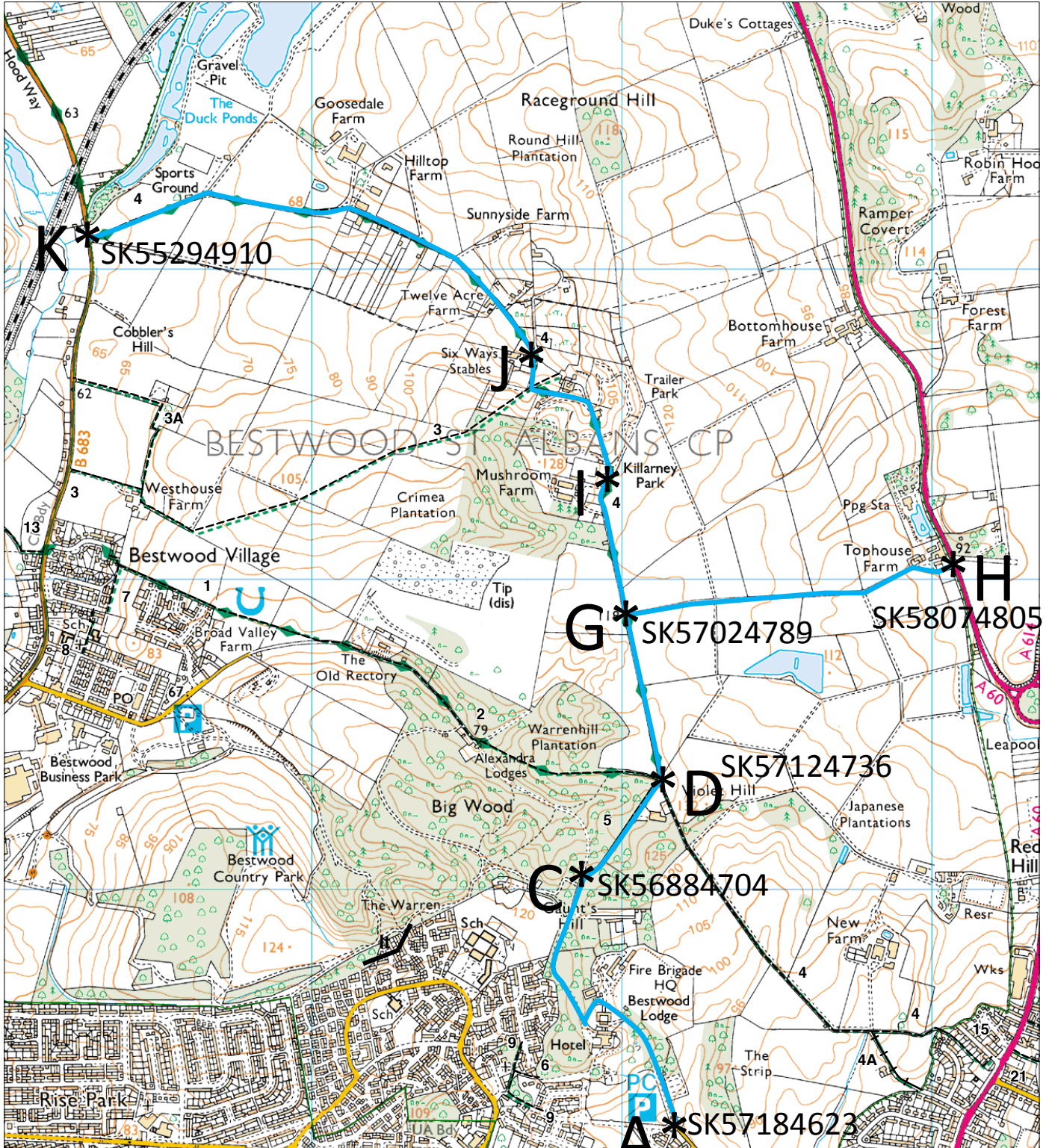
