

COMMONS ACT 2006 – SECTION 15(1)

Notice of an application for the registration of land as a Town or Village Green

To every reputed owner, lessee, tenant or occupier of any part of the land descried below, and to all others whom it may concern.

Application has been made to the registration authority, Nottinghamshire County Council of County Hall, West Bridgford, Nottingham NG2 7QP by Mr David Duffield on behalf of South Scarle Parish Meeting c/o Hall Farm House, Church Lane, South Scarle, Newark, Notts, under section 15(1) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons (Registration of Town or Village Greens) (Interim Arrangements) (England) Regulations 2007. The application seeks the inclusion in the Register of Town or Village Greens of the land described in the Schedule below, which is claimed to have qualified for registration as a town or village green on 27th of October 2020 by virtue of being used for not less than 20 years by a significant number of the inhabitants of the locality having indulged in lawful sports and pastimes on the land as of right.

The application, which includes a plan of the land proposed for registration may be inspected by appointment, at the office of the Nottinghamshire County Council Countryside Access Team at County Hall, West Bridgford, Nottingham NG2 7QP between the hours of 9.00am and 4.00pm Monday to Friday, and also at Newark and Sherwood District Council, Castle House, Great North Road, Newark, Notts NG24 1BY during normal office opening hours. If the registration authority is satisfied that the land described in the Schedule below qualifies for registration as a town or village green, it will so register the land.

Any person wishing to **object** to the registration of the land as a town or village green should send a statement of the facts on which the objection is based to Nottinghamshire County Council at the address below (quoting reference: Countryside Access-366NVG) so as to be received on or before the 22nd of September 2021. Any representations that are to be taken into account by the Registration Authority in reaching a decision on the application cannot be treated as confidential and will be copied to the applicant for comment and may be disclosed to other interested parties.
