

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (RADCLIFFE ON TRENT FOOTPATH NO.2) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council HAS MADE an ORDER, under Sections 14 and 15(8) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:

To continue the effects of THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (**RADCLIFFE ON TRENT FOOTPATH NO.2**) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) NOTICE **2025**.

That Notice came into force on 24th July 2025 and was continued in force by a second 21-day notice which came into force on 14th August 2025.

The effects are that: -

No person shall: - proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at Radcliffe on Trent in the Borough of Rushcliffe-

Radcliffe-on-Trent Footpath No.2 from the stile at the boundary between the Woodland Plantation and the Arable Field SK 64471 38227 to its junction with Cotgrave Footpath No.2 south of the footbridge SK 64536 37896.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction there is no direct alternative route on public rights of way.

IT IS INTENDED that the prohibition respecting the above highway or highways will apply as follows:-

To 23rd January 2026 inclusive.

The Continuation Order will come into force on 4th September 2025 and any prohibition contained in the continued Order shall apply on that day and on any subsequent day or days when it shall be necessary for the prohibition to apply to enable works to be carried out and the Order shall continue in full force until the works it is proposed to carry out are completed. The duration of this Order may be extended with the approval of the relevant Secretary of State.

The prohibition is required to protect public safety while essential repairs are completed to timber footbridges along this route.
