

**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BRIDLEWAY****THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(CLARBOROUGH BRIDLEWAY NO.25, SHADY LANE)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION NO.3 ORDER 2026**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Secretary of State Transport in pursuance of the powers conferred by Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 approves of The Nottinghamshire County Council (Clarborough Bridleway No.25, Shady Lane) (Temporary Prohibition) Notice 2025 (which came into force on 1<sup>st</sup> April 2025 and was continued in force by a Continuation Order until 30<sup>th</sup> September 2025 and was further continued in force by a Continuation No.2 Order until 31<sup>st</sup> March 2026 inclusive) being extended and continuing in force until 31<sup>st</sup> March 2027 or until completion of the relevant works, whichever is the sooner.

The Order has the following effect:-

No person shall: -

- (a) cause any pedal cycle to proceed,
- (b) cause any horse to proceed,
- (c) cause any animal to proceed,

in the following length of Bridleway at Clarborough in the District of Bassetlaw: -

**Clarborough Bridleway No.25, Shady Lane**, along its full length between Pinfold Lane and Little Gringley Lane.

**AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN** that during the period of restriction the bridleway will remain open to those on foot only, there is no direct alternative route available for other users on public rights of way.

If the works are not completed within the above period, the Order may be extended for a longer period with the further approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The prohibition is required to protect public safety particularly for those on horseback, due to severe erosion of the bridleway.
