Extra ways to pay for childcare

You may be able to use Tax-Free Childcare or Universal Credit Childcare to pay for your place with a registered childcare provider, such as childminder, nursery or preschool.

With a tax-free childcare account working parents with children aged 11 or under can get up to £2,000 per child, per year towards their childcare costs (or up to £4,000 for disabled children 16 or under). For every £8 you pay in to your account, the government will top up with an extra £2.

If you receive Universal Credit, you could claim back up to 85% of childcare costs for children under 17.

Did you know? This can also help you to pay for wraparound childcare for primary school aged children.
