

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(TRESWELL FOOTPATH NO.5) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) ORDER 2021**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this Notice to make an Order, under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:-

No person shall: - Proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at Treswell in the District of Bassetlaw: -

Treswell Footpath No.5 between grid reference points SK 8090 7936 and SK 8090 7959, a distance of 210 metres.

IT IS INTENDED that the prohibition will apply as follows:-

From Monday, 13th September 2021 until Friday, 12th November 2021 inclusive.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction the alternative route will be via Rampton Byway 13 (Torksey Street), Rampton Footpath No.4 continuing as Treswell Footpath No.3, and Outgang Lane and vice versa.

The prohibition shall apply to enable works to be carried out and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the footpath. It may also apply on subsequent days when it shall be necessary. If the works are not completed within 6 months, the Order may be extended.

The prohibition is required to enable installation of a new connection and meter for the power station, and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the footpath.

THIS CLOSURE WILL ONLY TAKE EFFECT WHEN SIGNS INDICATING CLOSURE ARE DISPLAYED
