- Upgrading to a bridleway Langar cum Barnstone FP17 from point **E** to point **F** on Langar cum Barnstone BW1.

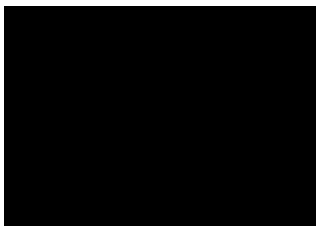
