

NOTICE OF MODIFICATION ORDER

WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981, SECTION 53

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE (AREA 6) DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(EVERTON BRIDLEWAY NO.30 & FOOTPATH NO.31 AND GRINGLEY ON THE HILL FOOTPATH NO.24 & BRIDLEWAY NO.25) MODIFICATION ORDER 2021

The above Order made on 27th of August 2021 under Section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the above Area by: 1) adding a public bridleway along the flood bank of the River Idle from the junction with Everton Bridleway No.27 at grid reference SK6878 9380 to a point SK7016 9444 and, 2) by adding a public bridleway along the flood bank from the junction with Everton Bridleway No.24 (Polly Bell Bank), SK7017 9442 to the junction with Gringley on the Hill Footpath No.17, SK7130 9500 and, 3) by adding a footpath from the northern end of Everton Bridleway No.24 leading to the River Idle between points SK7017 9442, SK7016 9444 and SK7018 9447 and, 4) by amending the definitive statement in respect of the northern termini of Everton Bridleway No.24. The foregoing is described in the Order and shown on the order maps.

A copy of the order, the order maps and the statement of reasons may be seen free of charge and by appointment at my Office at the address below between the hours of 9.00 am and 4.30 pm Mondays to Fridays inclusive, and at Bassetlaw District Council, Queens Buildings, Potter Street, Worksop, Nottinghamshire, and also at Retford Library, 17 Churchgate, Retford, Nottinghamshire, during the respective normal opening hours until Thursday the 21st of October 2021. Copies of the order and maps are available free of charge upon request.

Any representations about or objections to the Order must be received by the Countryside Access Team at the address given below (or by email: countryside.access@nottscc.gov.uk) not later than Thursday the 21st of October 2021. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or any part of it, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Nottinghamshire County Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State (or part of it if the Authority has by notice to the Secretary of State so elected under Paragraph 5 of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife & Countryside Act 1981) may itself confirm the Order (or that part of the Order) as an unopposed Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, (in whole or in part), any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
