THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(BEESTON FOOTPATH NO.55) DIVERSION ORDER 2021

This Order is made by the Nottinghamshire County Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath and the public it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

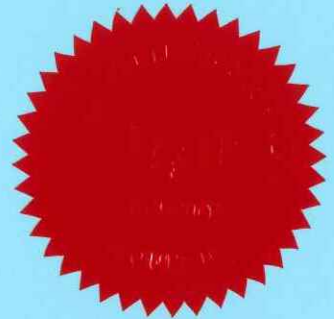
The Broxtowe Borough Council has been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situate at Beeston and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up after 7 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. There shall at the end of 7 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public right of way over the land situate at Beeston as described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

Description of Site of Existing Path or Way

Commencing from a point, SK 5254 3633, at the end of Lacemaker Road, previously known as Wilmot Lane, and proceeding in a north-north-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 83 metres to a point SK5250 3640, the junction with High Road, Chilwell.

PART 2

Description of Site of New Path or Way

Commencing from a point, SK 5253 3633, the hammerhead on Lacemaker Road, and proceeding in a north-north-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 82 metres to a point SK 5251 3640, the adopted road at High Road, Chilwell, and having a tarmac surface and a width of 2 metres throughout.
