


The facts about gritting in Nottinghamshire

1,560 kilometers of Nottinghamshire's roads are covered by the gritting network - further than driving from Land's End to John o'Groats



Each time we grit we spread an area of **1,050,000m²** - equivalent to **100** large football pitches

1,050,000m²

£11,600

Cost of each main route gritting run

200 tonnes

Approximately **200 tonnes** of rock salt are used for each gritting run



1,431 yellow grit bins for use by residents on pavements and roads, not private driveways



23 permanent drivers and **27** on stand by from November to March

How many times were gritters sent out?





We stockpile approx **17,000 tonnes** of salt at the start of winter, **100%** more than the official Government recommendation

63 local farmers on standby in case of severe weather, supported by **85** snow wardens



30 gritters in the fleet costing approximately **£100,000** each



Gritting every road in the county would cost an extra **£5.2 million**, plus an additional **£8 million** to pay for new equipment and salt storage
