The Nottinghamshire Outstanding Achievement 4Uth Award 2022/23

Information for people wishing to make a nomination

The Nottinghamshire Outstanding Achievement 40th Award is a Nottinghamshire County Council initiative to celebrate the achievements of young people across the county. First prize will be £250 in vouchers of the winner's choice

We are looking for nominations from members of the public including friends and family members along with schools, youth groups, voluntary organisations and other young people.

The award is about groups or individual young people being the best they can be, to celebrate those young people who have gone above and beyond by achieving or overcoming challenges. To be nominated a young person/group must fulfil the following criteria.

- 1. The young person must live in one of the seven County Council districts. This does not include those living within the Nottingham City boundaries.
- 2. Nominees must be at least old enough to be in Year 6 at school and no older than 19 (the maximum age for disabled young people is 24). Please note this year we will be accepting group nominations.
- 3. Young people should be nominated because they have achieved at an outstanding level within their own personal boundaries, either as an individual or as part of a group.
- 4. The young person/s and their parent or guardian (if aged under 18) gives consent to be involved in media coverage relating to the award. Please note images and video footage will be circulated on our social media platforms following the nominations. By agreeing to take part you are agreeing to this.
- 5. Deadline for nominations is midnight on June 21st 2022.
- 6. Panels of young people and adults will meet in each district. The panels will look at all nominations and select a winner from each district. The winner from each district will go forward for the county award. The overall winner will be selected by a final judges panel.
- 7. There will be a live awards evening in Autumn 2022 where young people will be presented with their awards and an overall winner announced.
