

NOTICE OF MODIFICATION ORDER

WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981, SECTION 53

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE (MANSFIELD DISTRICT) DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(WARSOP RESTRICTED BYWAY NOS. 61 & 62 AND BRIDLEWAY NO.63) MODIFICATION ORDER 2022

The above Order made on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of February 2022 under Section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the above Area by adding a restricted byway leading from Ordnance Survey grid reference SK 54036656 (Sookholme Bath) proceeding in a generally south-easterly direction along Ox Pasture Wood to SK 55076587 (Nettleworth Manor), and by upgrading a section of Warsop Footpath No.17 to a restricted byway from SK 55076587 proceeding in a generally East-South-Easterly direction along an access track to SK 55476564 (Leeming Lane), and also by adding a bridleway from SK 55266582 running across a field in a generally South-Easterly direction to SK 55446556 (Leeming Lane) as described in the Order and shown on the order map.

A copy of the order, the order maps and the statement of reasons may be seen free of charge at my Office at the address below between the hours of 9.00 am and 4.30 pm Mondays to Fridays inclusive, and at Mansfield District Council, Civic Centre, Chesterfield Road South, Mansfield, Nottinghamshire, and at Warsop Library, 30 High Street, Warsop, Nottinghamshire during the respective normal opening hours until Monday the 16<sup>th</sup> of May 2022. Copies of the Order and Map may be purchased from my Office at the address below at a cost of £5 per copy.

Any representations about or objections to the Order must be received by the Countryside Access Team at the address given below not later than 16<sup>th</sup> of May 2022. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or any part of it, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Nottinghamshire County Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State (or part of it if the Authority has by notice to the Secretary of State so elected under Paragraph 5 of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife & Countryside Act 1981) may itself confirm the Order (or that part of the Order) as an unopposed Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, (in whole or in part), any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
