MODIFICATION ORDER 2022

This Order is made by the Nottinghamshire County Council under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife & Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that Authority that the Nottinghamshire (Mansfield District) Definitive Map and Statement requires modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Sections 53(3)(c)(i) and 53(3)(c)(ii) of the Act, namely the discovery of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available) shows;

- (i) that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist and
- (ii) that a highway shown in the map and statement as a highway of a particular description ought to be there shown as a highway of a different description

The Authority have consulted with every Local Authority whose area includes land to which the Order relates.

The Nottinghamshire County Council hereby order that:

1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 24<sup>th</sup> January 2022.
2. The Nottinghamshire (Mansfield District) Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the Map attached to this Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as "The Nottinghamshire County Council (Warsop Restricted Byway Nos.61&62 and Bridleway No.63) Modification Order 2022".

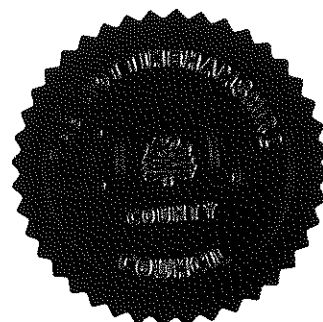
