

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

### THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (SUTTON IN ASHFIELD FOOTPATH NO.40) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) ORDER 2022

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this Notice to make an Order, under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:-

**No person shall:** - Proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at Sutton in Ashfield in the District of Ashfield: -

**Sutton in Ashfield Footpath No.40** between Little Lane and Nunn Brook Road

**IT IS INTENDED** that the prohibition will apply as follows:-

**From 30<sup>th</sup> May 2022 to 29<sup>th</sup> November 2022**

**AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN** that during the period of restriction there is no alternative route on public rights of way.

**The prohibition shall apply** to enable works to be carried and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the footpath. It may also apply on subsequent days when it shall be necessary. If the works are not completed within 6 months, the Order may be extended.

**The prohibition is required** to enable approved construction work alongside the footpath, and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the footpath.

**THIS CLOSURE WILL ONLY TAKE EFFECT WHEN SIGNS INDICATING CLOSURE ARE DISPLAYED**
