It is very important that a healthcare professional decides how to get rid of this kind of rubbish to make sure it is safe.




You cannot take healthcare waste to recycling centres.



Only infectious waste, needles and other sharps need a healthcare waste collection.








If you need a healthcare waste collection, your healthcare professional can ask for one using our online form.
