## **WORLD-FAMOUS CYCLE RACE THE TOUR OF BRITAIN RETURNS TO NOTTINGHAMSHIRE THIS AUTUMN.**

Nottinghamshire will host the showpiece event on Thursday 8 September – the fifth stage of this year's race.

It is the third time the sport's leading names will grace the county's roads following the staging of the Tour of Britain in 2017 and 2018.

This year's race will begin on Central Avenue in West Bridgford and end on Chesterfield Road South in Mansfield.

It will pass through several towns and villages in the county, including East Leake, Radcliffe on Trent, Calverton, Southwell, Retford and Worksop - as well as well-known landmarks and tourist destinations such as world-famous cricket ground Trent Bridge, the legendary Sherwood Forest and the popular visitor attraction Clumber Park.

The closing date is 18 July and the successful entrant will also receive a helmet featuring their winning design.



The winning design will be transferred onto the helmet using vinyl transfers so please don't use glittery pens. Felt tip pens and crayons will be acceptable.


