For adventurous activities for children and young people. **Notts Outdoors** are hosting events throughout the summer. Plus, there is a whole world of adventure to be had at your local library, with the **Summer Reading Challenge** running throughout the school holidays as well as lots of exciting events for families at local libraries.

We've also got some incredible events lined up across the county.

We'll be celebrating **Nottinghamshire Day** on the 25 August. This is an opportunity to celebrate the identity, heritage, culture, and local traditions of our county. You'll also enjoy time in the medieval camp of Robin Hood, Lady Marian and their band of Outlaws, and watch them do battle against the Sheriff and Prince John in an exhilarating two-part combat show Lionheart. You can even try your hand at axe throwing, crossbow shooting and catapulting.

The fun doesn't end with the summer holidays! Looking ahead to September, we'll have the **Tour of Britain** passing through many towns and villages dotted along the route between West Bridgford and Mansfield as the fifth stage of the race takes place. We're encouraging Nottinghamshire residents to create eye-catching land art along the route - I can't wait to see Notts get creative and once again make it a sporting spectacle to remember.

Bikeability is today's cycle training programme in schools. It's like cycling proficiency, but better!

From learning the basics of riding on balance bikes, all the way through to navigating busy roads and junctions, our cycle training programme supports young people in their journey to become safe and active cyclists.

In addition to Bikeability training in schools, Via in partnership with Nottinghamshire County Council, are now offering Bikeability Plus Family. A new course which helps families cycle more together.

The courses are FREE if you live in Nottinghamshire. Your family group must include at least one over 18-year-old and one under 18-year-old. You don't have to all live in the same household or be related but you do need to be keen to get everyone together on their bikes!

Bestwood Country Park was once a royal hunting ground: the site of Richard III's last days before the Battle of Bosworth and Charles II's trysts with Nell Gwyn. Later, it housed Bestwood Colliery. The restored Winding Engine House and Dynamo House are open on Saturday mornings: a cafe run by volunteers from the Friends group serves homemade cakes, raising funds for projects in the park to promote and enhance the area for people and wildlife. 700 acres can be explored on foot, cycle or horseback. The old pit tips offer amazing views of the surrounding area. Come and see what you have been missing.
