This Order is made by the Nottinghamshire County Council ("the Authority") under Section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that the public footpath described in Paragraph 1 below is not needed for public use.

This Order is also made under Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the Authority that the Nottinghamshire Area 4 Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53 (3) (a) (i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the stopping up (as authorised by this Order) of a highway hitherto shown or required to be shown in the Map and Statement.

The Newark and Sherwood District Council and East Stoke with Thorpe Parish Council have been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated at East Stoke shown by a continuous bold line on the Map attached to this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be extinguished upon confirmation of this Order, and thereupon the Nottinghamshire Area 4 Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way, and the Definitive Statement shall be modified as described in part 2 of the Schedule to this Order.

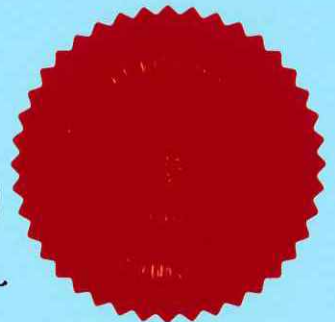

