

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BARTON IN FABIS FOOTPATH NO.4) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this Notice to make an Order, under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:-

No person shall: - Proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at Barton in Fabis in the Borough of Rushcliffe:-

Barton in Fabis Footpath No.4 between its junction with Nottingham Road at grid reference point SK 5443 3334 and SK 5443 3297 its junction with a new spur of roadway and the remainder of the footpath, a distance of 380 metres.

IT IS INTENDED that the prohibition will apply as follows:-

From 1st March 2023 until 31st August 2023 inclusive.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction the only alternative route will be alongside the road on pavements.

The prohibition shall apply to enable works to be carried out and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the footpath. It may also apply on subsequent days when it shall be necessary. If the works are not completed within 6 months, the Order may be extended.

The prohibition is required to enable progression of approved development and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the footpath.

THIS CLOSURE WILL ONLY TAKE EFFECT WHEN SIGNS INDICATING CLOSURE ARE DISPLAYED
