

Greasley Footpath No. 32

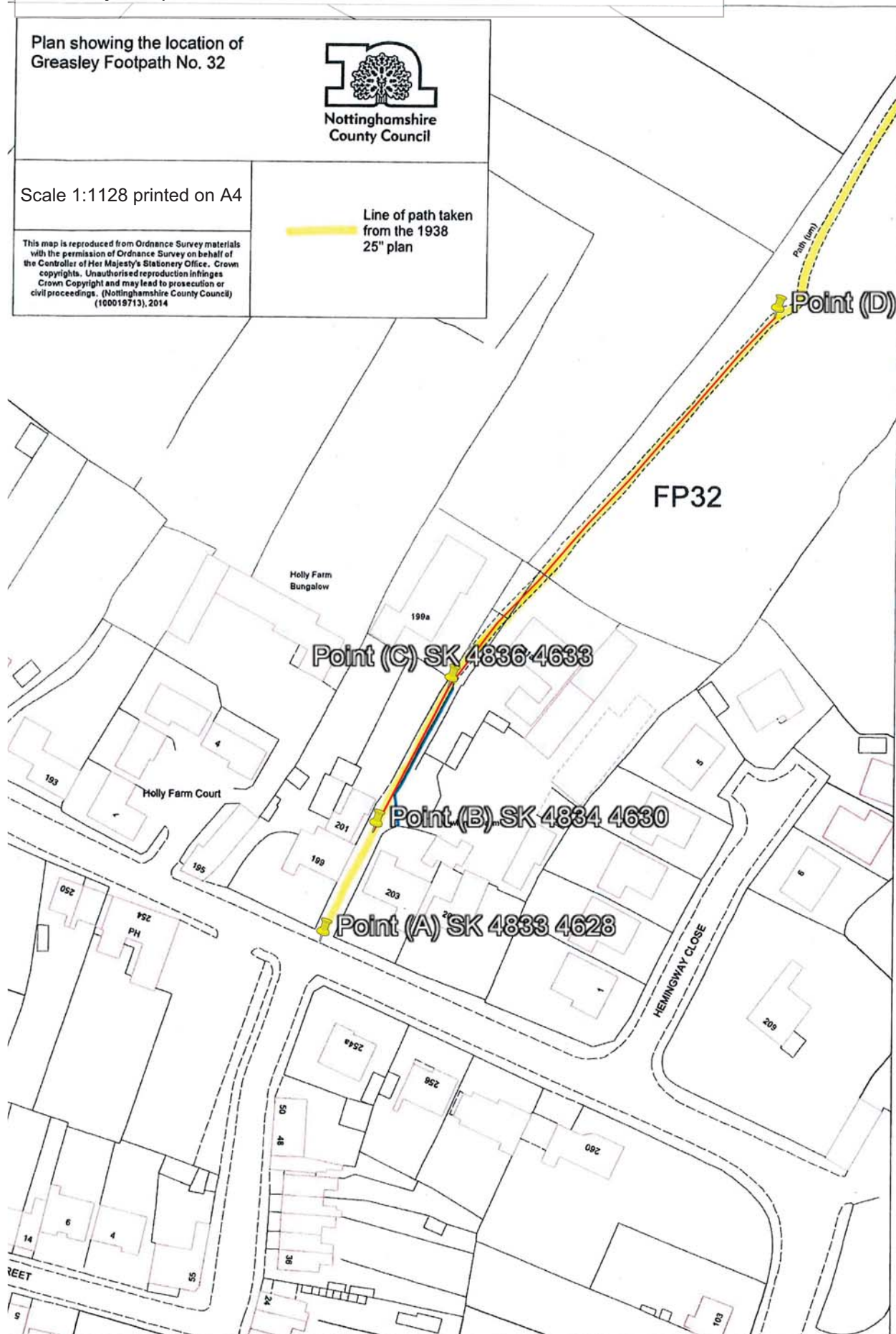
