

## **TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BRIDLEWAY**

### **THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (EAST LEAKE BRIDLEWAY NO.15) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION NO.2 ORDER 2025**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Secretary of State Transport in pursuance of the powers conferred by Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 approves of "The Nottinghamshire County Council (East Leake Bridleway No.15) (Temporary Prohibition) Notice 2025" (which came into force on 20<sup>th</sup> June 2025 and was continued in force by a Continuation Order until 19<sup>th</sup> December 2025 inclusive) being extended and continuing in force until 19<sup>th</sup> June 2026 or until completion of the relevant works, whichever is the sooner.

The Order has the following effect:-

No person shall: -

- (a) proceed on foot,
- (b) cause any pedal cycle to proceed,
- (c) cause any horse to proceed,
- (d) cause any animal to proceed

in the following length of Bridleway at East Leake in the Borough of Rushcliffe:-

**East Leake Bridleway No.15**, between its junction with Gotham Bridleway No.8 and its junction with East Leake Bridleway No.17.

**AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN** that during the period of restriction the alternative route available for all users is Gotham Bridleway No.9, Leake Road, Bunny Lane, Bunny Bridleway No.9, Gotham Bridleway No.17 and vice versa – there are other routes available for pedestrians between Gotham and Bunny.

If the works are not completed within the above period, the Order may be extended for a longer period with the further approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The prohibition is required to protect public safety due to a damaged bridges which will be replaced very shortly.
