

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(HOLME LANE, HOLME PIERREPONT)**  
**(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) NOTICE 2024 (R24-079)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council (in exercise of its powers under Section 14(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984) being the traffic authority for the length or lengths of road referred to in this Notice, hereby directs, because the restriction or prohibition should come into force without delay, that: -

1. **Vehicles are prohibited from proceeding** in the following length of road at **Holme Pierrepont** in the **Borough of Rushcliffe**:

**Holme Lane, Holme Pierrepont** – from a point 10 metres east of its junction with Adbolton Lane in an easterly direction for a distance of 260 metres

**The alternative route will be as follows:**

None available

This **Notice shall come into force** on:

**Monday 11<sup>th</sup> March 2024** for a maximum of 21days, the Notice maybe continued by a further 21day Notice and or a Continuation Order which has a maximum duration of 18months

Due to the likelihood of danger to the public, or of serious damage to the road due to overnight closures of the A52 between Gamston and Bingham

The Prohibition is expected to be in force:

**From 20:00 hours on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> March 2024**  
**Until 06:00 hours on Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> March 2024**

**Further Notice**

- a) No prohibition, restriction or prescription contained in this Notice shall apply to any vehicle
  - being used for police, fire or ambulance purposes,
  - proceeding at the direction, or with the permission of, a police officer, or
  - being used for duties in connection with the said works
- b) Nothing in this Notice shall apply so as to make it unlawful for any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in this Notice for the purposes of access to or egress from premises, provided that the said access or egress may only be gained by proceeding over that length of road and provided that the works being carried out would not be inconveniently interrupted.
- c) Any existing restrictions or prohibitions previously introduced on any lengths of road mentioned above by an order made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 may be temporarily suspended if appropriate for so long as this notice is in force and traffic signs are in place.
- d) For so long as, and to the extent that, traffic signs (authorised under the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions in force on the date this Notice is made) indicating the effect of the prohibitions contained in this Notice are placed, that prohibition shall be enforced.
