

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(EASTWOOD FOOTPATH NO.27)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION NO.2 ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State Transport in pursuance of the powers conferred by Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 approves of "The Nottinghamshire County Council (Eastwood Footpath No.27) (Temporary Prohibition) Order 2024" (which came into force on 26th August 2024 and was continued in force by a Continuation Order which came into force on 26th February 2025 and remains in force to 25th February 2026 inclusive) being extended and continuing in force until 25th February 2027 or until completion of the relevant works, whichever is the sooner.

The Order has the following effect:-

No person shall: -

- (a) proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at Eastwood in the Borough of Broxtowe:-

Eastwood Footpath No.27 between Garden Road and Footpath No.45, a distance of approximately 150 metres.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction the alternative route will be via Garden Road, Lyncroft and Walker Street and vice versa.

If the works are not completed within the above period, the Order may be extended for a longer period with the further approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The prohibition is required to enable construction of approved housing development and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the footpath.
