

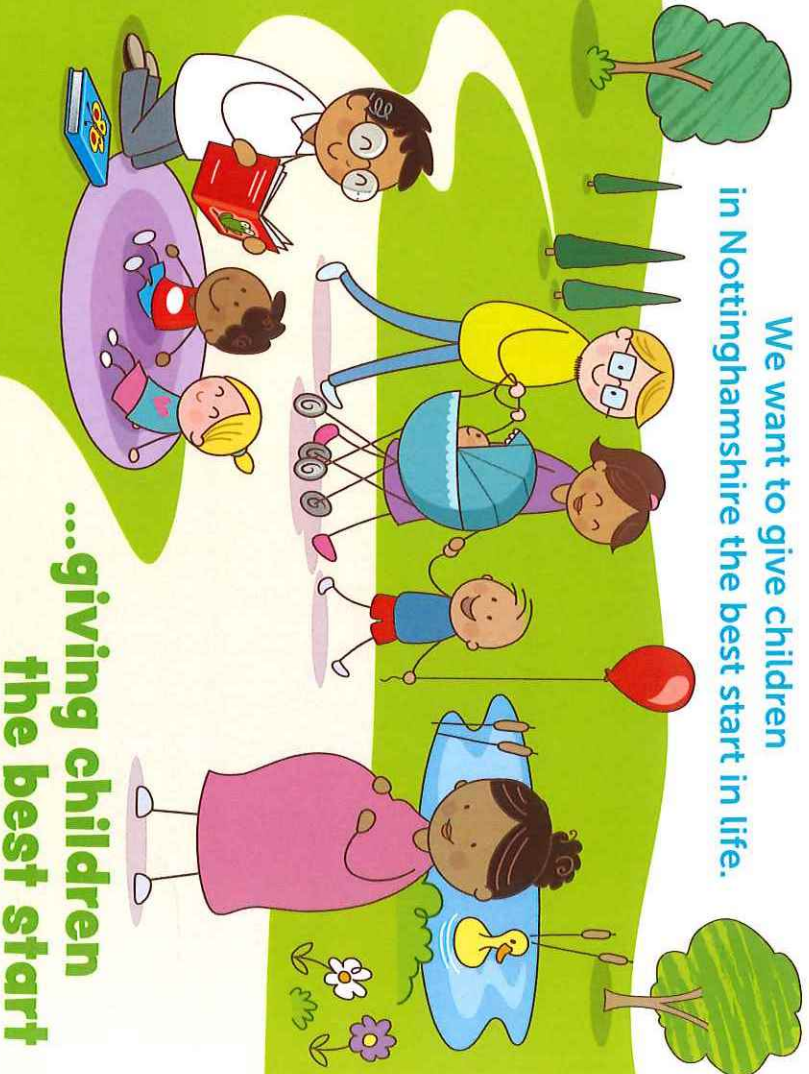

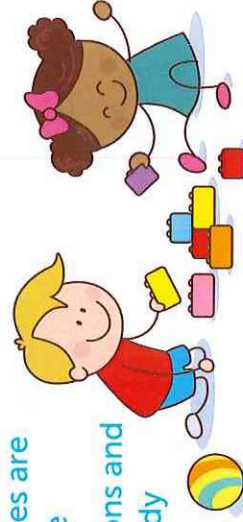

Our workers have expertise in family support, developing parenting skills, promoting health and wellbeing, early years development, communication and language and supporting parents to be ready for work. The service works with partner agencies to ensure we support families in whatever area they need.

The service delivers work to enable:

- Children and families to be happy and healthy
- Children to be ready for school and achieve developmental milestones
- Children to be safe and families are supported as early as possible
- Parents to have high aspirations and are supported to be work ready



Where do we deliver our service?

The service is provided in family homes, community venues, local parks and dedicated Children's Centre buildings.

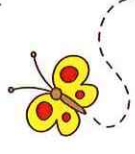
Each team has its own timetable of weekly activities and support programmes, including appointments in the home, which vary according to the needs of the local area.

Qualified Children's Centre Service workers offer one-to-one or group support with:

- having a healthy pregnancy
- preparing for a baby
- attachment with your baby
- children's development, including listening, speech, language and communication
- playing with your child



- the emotional health of you or your child
- children's behaviour
- feeding your child
- increasing your confidence and skills to help you get a job
- volunteering opportunities
- preparing for nursery and school
- help with childcare
- reducing parental conflict
- health and wellbeing
- money management



Children's Centre volunteers offer one-to-one or group support through:

- BABES breastfeeding peer support groups
- Under Ones groups
- Stay & Play groups for under fives
