

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(ARNOLD FOOTPATH NO.3)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) ORDER 2025**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council has made an Order, under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be: -

No person shall: - Proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at Arnold in the Borough of Gedling:-

Arnold Footpath No.3, between Mapperley Plains (B684) and Crawford Rise, Arnold

IT IS INTENDED that the prohibition will apply as follows:-

From 13th January 2025 until 12th July 2025 inclusive.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction there is an alternative route around the development.

The prohibition shall apply to enable works to be carried out and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the footpath. It may also apply on subsequent days when it shall be necessary. If the works are not completed within 6 months, the Order may be extended.

The prohibition is required to enable construction of a new housing development, and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the footpath.
