



TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BRIDLEWAY

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(EAST LEAKE BRIDLEWAY NO.15)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION ORDER 2025**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council HAS MADE an ORDER, under Sections 14 and 15(8) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:

To continue the effects of THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (**EAST LEAKE BRIDLEWAY NO.15**) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) NOTICE **2025**.

That Notice came into force on 20th June 2025.

The effects are that: -

No person shall: -

- (a) proceed on foot,
- (b) cause any pedal cycle to proceed,
- (c) cause any horse to proceed,
- (d) cause any animal to proceed

in the following length of Bridleway at East Leake in the Borough of Rushcliffe:

East Leake Bridleway No.15, between its junction with Gotham Bridleway No.8 and its junction with East Leake Bridleway No.17.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction the alternative route available for all users is Gotham Bridleway No.9, Leake Road, Bunny Lane, Bunny Bridleway No.9, Gotham Bridleway No.17 and vice versa – there are other routes available for pedestrians between Gotham and Bunny.

IT IS INTENDED that the prohibition respecting the above highway or highways will apply as follows: -

To 19th December 2025 inclusive.

The Continuation Order will come into force on 11th July 2025 and any prohibition contained in the continued Order shall apply on that day and on any subsequent day or days when it shall be necessary for the prohibition to apply to enable works to be carried out and the Order shall continue in full force until the works it is proposed to carry out are completed. The duration of this Order may be extended with the approval of the relevant Secretary of State.

The prohibition is required to protect public safety due to a damaged bridge which will need to be replaced.
