

**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATHS**

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(EPPERSTONE FOOTPATH NO.14, OXTON FOOTPATH NO.9 AND CALVERTON**  
**FOOTPATH NO.7)**  
**(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION NO.2 ORDER 2026**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Secretary of State Transport in pursuance of the powers conferred by Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 approves of "The Nottinghamshire County Council (Epperstone Footpath No.14, Oxtton Footpath No.9 and Calverton Footpath No.7) (Temporary Prohibition) Notice 2025" (which came into force on 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2025 and was continued in force by a further 21 Day Notice and then a Continuation Order, which remains in force until 1<sup>st</sup> March 2026 inclusive) being extended and continuing in force until 1<sup>st</sup> March 2027 or until completion of the relevant works, whichever is the sooner.

The Order has the following effect:-

No person shall: -

- (a) proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at Epperstone and Oxtton in the District of Newark and Sherwood and Calverton in the Borough of Gedling:-

**Epperstone Footpath No.14, Oxtton Footpath No.9 and Calverton**  
**Footpath No.7, their entire length.**

**AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN** that during the period of restriction there are alternative routes available for pedestrians as shown on the accompanying plan.

If the works are not completed within the above period the Order may be extended for a longer period with the further approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.
