

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (RADCLIFFE ON TRENT FOOTPATH NO.2) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION NO.2 ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State Transport in pursuance of the powers conferred by Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 approves of The Nottinghamshire County Council (Radcliffe on Trent Footpath No.2) (Temporary Prohibition) Notice 2025 (which came into force 24th July 2025 and was continued in force by a Continuation Order until 23rd January 2026 inclusive) being extended and continuing in force until 23rd July 2026 or until completion of the relevant works, whichever is the sooner.

The Order has the following effect:-

No person shall: -

- (a) proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at Radcliffe on Trent in the Borough of Rushcliffe:-

Radcliffe on Trent Footpath No.2 from the stile at the boundary between the Woodland Plantation and the Arable Field SK 64471 38227 to its junction with Cotgrave Footpath No.2 south of the footbridge SK 64536 37896.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction there is no direct alternative route on public rights of way.

If the works are not completed within the above period the Order may be extended for a longer period with the further approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The prohibition is required to protect public safety while essential repairs are completed to timber footbridges along this route.
