## 4 Oversubscription criteria

1	Looked after children and previously looked after children.
2	Children who live in the catchment area on the closing date for applications and who, at the time of admission, will have a sibling attending the academy
3	Other children who live in the catchment area at the closing date for applications.
4	Children who live outside the catchment area and who, at the time of admission, will have a sibling attending the academy.
5	Children who live outside the catchment area but who are attending the academy nursery class on the closing date for applications.
6	Children of staff who have been employed at the academy for at least two years and/or are recruited to fill a demonstrable skill shortage.
7	Other children
