

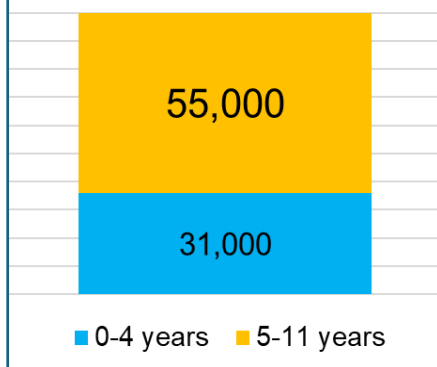

Children living in Nottinghamshire

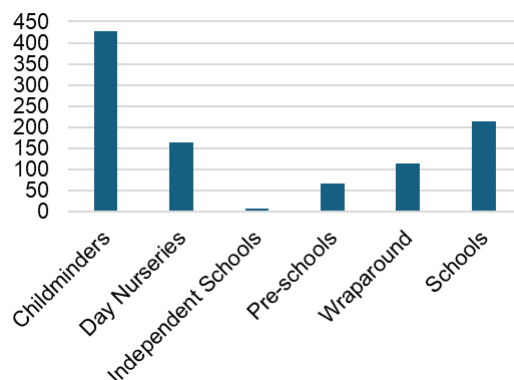


There are around 31,000 children under five, and 55,000 primary school aged children living in Nottinghamshire at the moment.

There are over 1,000 registered providers of Childcare for children aged 0-4 years.

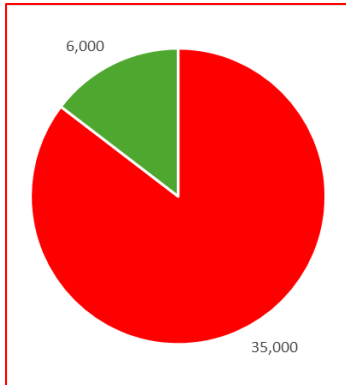


Providers in Nottinghamshire





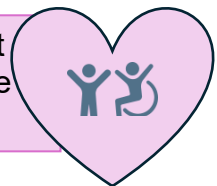
87% of our Early Years Provision is Good or Outstanding



There are about 6,000 vacant Early Years places available across Nottinghamshire. Some areas have less spare places than others, especially for Babies and Younger Children.



About 7,500 children and families were given additional funding support because they need extra help. These children could be from low income families or have special educational needs or disabilities.



95% of Nottinghamshire's schools offer some form of Wraparound Childcare.

Parents get information about childcare in their area by using Notts Help Yourself Families Information Service and around 95,000 parents and carers looked for information.
