

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(STAYTHORPE FOOTPATH NO.1)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) ORDER 2026**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this Notice to make an Order, under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:-

No person shall: - proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at Staythorpe in the District of Newark and Sherwood: -

Staythorpe Footpath No.1, its entire length between the start and end point of the permissive footpath.

IT IS INTENDED that the prohibition will apply as follows:-

From 6th May 2026 to 22nd September 2026 inclusive.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction the alternative routes will be via the permissive footpath around the perimeter of the site.

The prohibition shall apply to enable works to be carried out and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the footpath. It may also apply on subsequent days when it shall be necessary. If the works are not completed within 6 months, the Order may be extended.

The prohibition is required to enable overhead powerline diversion works, and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the footpath.

THIS CLOSURE WILL ONLY TAKE EFFECT WHEN SIGNS INDICATING CLOSURE ARE DISPLAYED
