

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (EAST BRIDGFORD FOOTPATH NO.24) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State Transport in pursuance of the powers conferred by Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 approves of The Nottinghamshire County Council (EAST BRIDGFORD FOOTPATH NO.24) (Temporary Prohibition) Order 2024 (which came into force on 2nd September 2024 and continues in force until 1st March 2025 inclusive) being extended and continuing in force until 1st March 2026 or until completion of the relevant works, whichever is the sooner.

The Order has the following effect:-

No person shall: -

(a) proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at East Bridgford in the Borough of Rushcliffe:-

East Bridgford Footpath No.24, from Butt Lane across first field.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction the developer has agreed to maintain a path through the works site, alternatives are also available for anytime when this is not possible.

If the works are not completed within the above period, the Order may be extended for a longer period with the further approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The prohibition is required to enable approved development works to be carried out, and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the footpath.
