

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATHS

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL **(KNEESALL FOOTPATH NO.3 AND EAKRING FOOTPATH NO.12)** **(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION NO.4 ORDER 2025**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State Transport in pursuance of the powers conferred by Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 approves of The Nottinghamshire County Council (Kneesall Footpath No.3) (Temporary Prohibition) Notice 2023 (which came into force on 29th November 2023 and was continued in force by a Continuation Order which remained in force until 28th May 2024, and was further continued by a Continuation No.2 Order which remained in force until 28th May 2025 and was then further continued by a Continuation No.3 Order which remains in force until 28th November 2025 inclusive) being extended and continuing in force until 28th May 2026 or until completion of the relevant works, whichever is the sooner.

The Order has the following effect:-

No person shall: -

(a) proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at Kneesall and Eakring in the District of Newark and Sherwood: -

Kneesall Footpath No.3 and Eakring Footpath No.12 at the footbridge on the Parish boundary at Penny Pasture Common.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction there is no direct alternative route available for pedestrians.

If the works are not completed within the above period the Order may be extended for a longer period with the further approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The prohibition is required to enable works to be carried out to replace a damaged footbridge and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the footpath.
