

NOTICE OF MODIFICATION ORDER

WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981, SECTION 53

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE (AREA 7) DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (EDINGLEY FOOTPATH NO.1
AND KIRKLINGTON FOOTPATH NO.14)
MODIFICATION ORDER 2026

The above Order made on 6th day of March 2026 under Section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the above Area by:

adding part of Edingley Footpath No.1 commencing from a point, SK 6740 5663, at the junction with the remainder of Edingley Footpath No.1, at a pedestrian gate on the northern boundary of Southwell Trail and proceeding in a generally northerly direction for a distance of approximately 40 metres to the parish boundary at SK 6740 5667 at the junction with Kirklington Footpath No.14 and;

then adding a footpath commencing from a point, SK 6740 5667, at the junction with Edingley Footpath No.1, at the parish boundary and proceeding in a generally north-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 497 metres to a point SK 6752 5715 at the junction with Southwell Road, as described in the Order and shown on the order map.

Paper copies of the Order and Map may be purchased from my Office at the address below at a cost of £5 per copy.

Any representations about or objections to the Order must be received by the Countryside Access Team at the address given below not later than Friday 1st May 2026. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or any part of it, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Nottinghamshire County Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State (or part of it if the Authority has by notice to the Secretary of State so elected under Paragraph 5 of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife & Countryside Act 1981) may itself confirm the Order (or that part of the Order) as an unopposed Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, (in whole or in part), any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
