

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Variation of Permit Scheme) Order 2025

The Nottinghamshire County Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 33A and 33B of the Traffic Management Act 2004, and in accordance with the provisions of the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007 (SI 2007/3372) as amended by the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2015 (SI 2015/958), makes the following Order:

1. Citation, Commencement, and Application

- 1.1 This Order may be cited as **The Nottinghamshire County Council (Variation of Permit Scheme) Order 2025**.
- 1.2 This Order shall come into force on 1st October 2025.
- 1.3 This Order applies to the area covered by the Nottinghamshire County Council Permit Scheme, which came into effect on 1st April 2020 (hereinafter referred to as the "2020 Order").

2. Interpretation

- 2.1 For the purposes of this Order:
 - 2.1.1 2004 Act means the Traffic Management Act 2004.
 - 2.1.2 2007 Regulations means the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007 (SI 2007/3372), as amended.
 - 2.1.3 The 2020 Order refers to the Nottinghamshire County Council Permit Scheme Order 2020.
 - 2.1.4 The Permit Scheme means the scheme set out in the 2020 Order as amended by this Variation Order.
- 2.2 Words and expressions used in this Order, unless otherwise defined, have the meaning ascribed to them in the 2004 Act, the 2007 Regulations, or the 2020 Order.

3. Variation of the 2020 Permit Scheme Order

3.1 Revision of Permit Fees

- 3.1.1 The schedule of permit fees in Schedule 10.2 of the 2020 Order is replaced with the revised permit fee schedule set out in Schedule 1 to this Variation Order.
- 3.1.2 The new fees shall apply to all permit applications submitted on or after 1st October 2025.
- 3.1.3 The revised fees comply with regulation 16 of the 2007 Regulations, ensuring:
 - 3.1.3.1 The fees are consistent with the costs of operating the permit scheme, without exceeding their recovery;
 - 3.1.3.2 Fees are proportionate to the administrative burden and management obligations required for each permit type.

4. Transitional Arrangements

- 4.1 Applications for permits submitted before 1st October 2025 shall remain subject to the terms and fee structure outlined in the 2020 Order.
- 4.2 Any permit amendments, variations, or cancellations requested on or after 1st October 2025 shall be subject to the revised fee structure in this Order.
- 4.3 The revised fees shall be reviewed periodically in accordance with regulation 16A of the 2007 Regulations, and any further variations to the fee structure shall be made in compliance with statutory requirements.

5. Publicity and Notification Requirements

- 5.1 A notice of this Variation Order and its key details shall be published in accordance with regulation 3 of the 2007 Regulations, no later than 28 days before the Order takes effect.
- 5.2 The 2020 Order, as amended by this Variation Order, shall be made accessible to the public:
 - a. At the principal offices of Nottinghamshire County Council; and
 - b. On the official website of the Nottinghamshire County Council (www.nottinghamshire.gov.uk).

Explanatory Note

(This Note Does Not Form Part of the Order)

This Variation Order amends the **Nottinghamshire County Council Permit Scheme Order 2020**, which established a permit scheme under the **Traffic Management Act 2004**.

The purpose of this Variation Order is to revise the permit fee structure under the scheme to ensure compliance with regulation **16 of the 2007 Regulations**, which requires that permit fees reflect the reasonable costs of operating the permit scheme without exceeding those costs.

The revised fees will take effect from **1st October 2025** and will apply to all permit applications submitted on or after this date. Transitional provisions have been included to ensure that applications made prior to this date will remain subject to the 2020 Order's fee provisions.
