The above order was made on 8<sup>th</sup> May 2026, under section 118A of the Highway Act 1980. The order will extinguish a section of Burton Joyce Footpath No.6 across the railway at Chestnut Grove, Burton Joyce, Nottinghamshire.

Any representations about or objections to the order may be sent in writing to the Countryside Access Team not later than 19<sup>th</sup> June 2026. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Nottinghamshire County Council may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
