

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BRIDLEWAY

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(COTGRAVE BRIDLEWAY NO.5)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION NO.2 ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State Transport in pursuance of the powers conferred by Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 approves of The Nottinghamshire County Council (Cotgrave Bridleway No.5) (Temporary Prohibition) Order 2025 (which came into force on 6th January 2025 and was continued in force by a Continuation Order came into force on 6th July 2025 and which remains in force until 5th July 2026 inclusive) being extended and continuing in force until 5th July 2027 or until completion of the relevant works, whichever is the sooner.

The Order has the following effect: -

No person shall: -

- (a) proceed on foot,
- (b) cause any pedal cycle to proceed,
- (c) cause any horse to proceed,
- (d) cause any animal to proceed

in the following length of Bridleway at Cotgrave in the Borough of Rushcliffe:-

Cotgrave Bridleway No.5 its entire length between Colston Gate and Hollygate Lane.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction the developer will provide an alternative route around the development whenever possible.

If the works are not completed within the above period, the Order may be extended for a longer period with the further approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The prohibition is required to enable approved development and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the bridleway.
