

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (THORPE FOOTPATH NO.1) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council has made an Order, under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be: -

No person shall: - Proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at Thorpe in the District of Newark and Sherwood: -

Thorpe Footpath No.1 where it crosses a timber footbridge over the drain at grid reference point SK 7660 5013

IT IS INTENDED that the prohibition will apply as follows:-

From 23rd February 2025 until 22nd August 2025 inclusive.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction there is no alternative route on public rights of way.

The prohibition shall apply to enable works to be carried and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the footpath. It may also apply on subsequent days when it shall be necessary. If the works are not completed within 6 months, the Order may be extended.

The prohibition is required to protect public safety following damage to the footbridge and to enable repair or replacement.

THIS CLOSURE WILL ONLY TAKE EFFECT WHEN SIGNS INDICATING CLOSURE ARE DISPLAYED
