

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (LAMBLEY FOOTPATH NO.23) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council HAS MADE an ORDER, under Sections 14 and 15(8) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:

To continue the effects of THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (<u>Lambley</u> <u>Footpath No.23</u>) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) NOTICE <u>2025</u>.

That Notice came into force on 29th August 2025

The effects are that:-

No person shall: -

(a) proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at Lambley in the Borough of Gedling-

<u>Lambley Footpath No.23</u>, from its junction with Lambley Footpath No.21 in a westerly direction alongside the dumble and up to Catfoot Lane.

<u>AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN</u> that during the period of restriction there is no direct alternative route available for pedestrians on public rights of way.

<u>IT IS INTENDED</u> that the prohibition respecting the above highway or highways will apply as follows:-

To 28th February 2026 inclusive.

The Continuation Order will come into force on 19th September 2025 and any prohibition contained in the continued Order shall apply on that day and on any subsequent day or days when it shall be necessary for the prohibition to apply to enable works to be carried out and the Order shall continue in full force until the works it is proposed to carry out are completed The duration of this Order may be extended with the approval of the relevant Secretary of State.

The prohibition is required to protect public safety due to landslip on footpath and to enable repairs to be made.
