Published admission number (PAN)

The published admission number for entry to the academy in year 7 is 240.

Sixth form: 120 (of which year 12 is 60) The external PAN for year 12 is 10. If fewer than 60 of the academy's own year 11 pupils transfer into year 12, additional external pupils will be admitted until year 12 reaches its capacity of 60

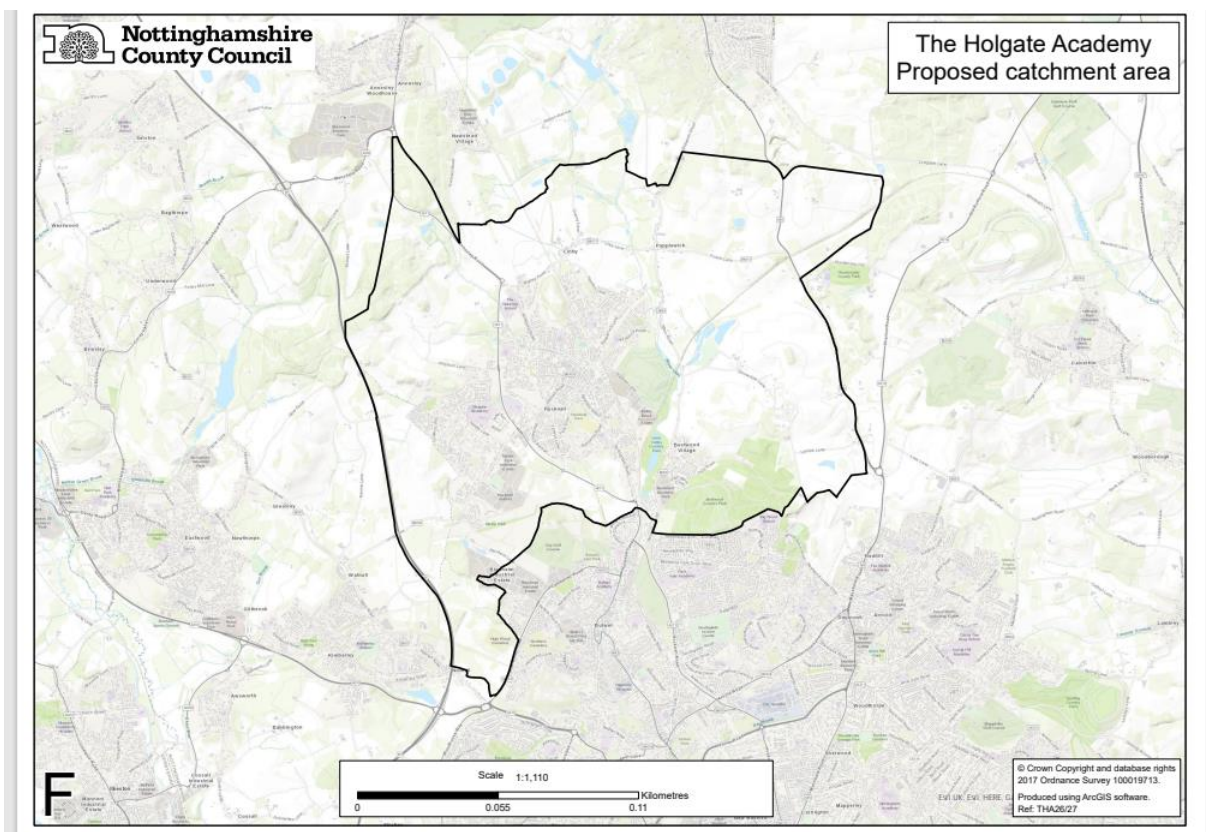

Admission to the Holgate Sixth Form is open to both external and internal applicants meeting the admission criteria.
